4. Duck and linen. – Kinds of tape
5. Past prime time. – Over the hill at I.R.P.
6. Put the business behind you. – At I.R.P., turn your back to downtown, face east.
7. Sun upside down. – Sunup = east side I.R.P
8. Twice ejected. – Tapes ejected, then discarded.
9. A surprise whack Bushwhack – under a bush
10. Flat or sad, go south – flat/sad=iron. South of Iron Ave.
11. There is a cart on there. – Carton holding tapes.
